**How to Change the Screen Resolution on Windows 8**  
If anyone else seems to be running into this issue, Windows 8.1 added a new feature called "Desktop Display Scaling" to scale things differently on different displays. For example, on a smaller screen with higher resolution, you could have Windows slightly enlarge for readability. This option is enabled by default.

**Windows 8.1 - Monitor Resolution not detected properly ...**  
In Windows, you can change the resolution and scaling to make things clearer for your eyes and easier to use. Screen resolution refers to the clarity of the text and images shown on the screen. At higher resolutions, such as 1600 x 1200 pixels, items appear sharper. They also appear smaller so more items can fit on the screen.
